

Air India Starts Cadet Pilot Program For HSc Pass Students

Air India is setting up its own Training Academy in Gurgaon, India, to impart training to pilots, cabin crew, ground staff, security personnel and engineers. And has partnered with leading flying schools from across the globe. Candidates can join the **2-Year Cadet Pilot Program after clearing their Class 12 exams**.

The Air India Training Academy is in partnership with global original equipment manufacturers (OEM) to provide best-in-class training support and to create a customised curriculum that meets the standards envisaged by Air India. The Training Academy will house simulators for pilot training across the Air India fleet where Commercial Pilot License (CPL) holders from the Air India Cadet Pilot Programme will be given type ratings as per Air India's fleet requirements.

Selection process

- Phase 1: Screening -The candidate applications will be evaluated based on the defined eligibility criteria.
- Phase 2: Online Assessment - Online assessment to assess their quantitative & behavioural skills.
- Phase 3: Personal Interview - will be asked to report to Air India Training Academy for personal interviews.
